The President's FY26 budget request proposes a whopping 84% cut to diplomatic, development, and humanitarian resources. We need Democrats' help to push back on this gutting of our diplomatic, development, and humanitarian capacity and encourage Member offices to continue to support programs and agencies that they have supported in the past despite the Trump Administration's actions to eliminate or severely cut these critical programs.

As you consider your FY26 request submissions, we hope you will consider requesting <u>funding at the enacted level</u> for priorities that are greatly under threat.
