Please read all material carefully, complete all required forms, and provide all requested data or information by **5pm EST on October 31, 2025**. Please note that mailing your packet to our D.C. office will *drastically* delay the handling of your application. - Current photo
- 3 letters of recommendation in sealed envelopes with signatures across the seal on the back mailed to our Delray Beach office (Address listed below)
- A personal statement in no more than 500 words explaining why you wish to attend a service academy
- Another personal statement written in no more than 500 words describing attributes that would make you successful at your desired service academy
- Official high school, junior college, or college transcripts
- SAT or ACT test scores sent to our Delray Beach office from the testing facility. When you take the SAT, please use the code 5673 to report the scores to us. For the ACT, please use the code 7342

Transcripts

Please include your high school and/or college transcripts. Your transcripts must be official and show your final grades from junior year, along with your GPA and class rank.

SAT or ACT Scores

Either your SAT or ACT scores must be submitted as part of your application. Scores should be submitted directly from the testing center to our Delray Beach office by 5 pm on October 31, 2025. Please note that if you are requesting the testing center to resend earlier scores, it may take 2-4 weeks for our office to receive the scores. To send your SAT scores, please use the code 5673; for the ACT, please use the code 7342.

General Information

The Nomination and Appointment Process

In order to attend a United States Service Academy, one must receive an appointment. Before one is eligible to receive an appointment, each applicant must obtain a nomination from one of the authorized nominating sources. The President of the United States, the Vice President of the United States, and members of the United States Senate and of the United States House of Representatives may nominate applicants who meet the eligibility requirements established by law. Applicants may apply for and receive nominations from the Vice President, their United States Senators and their Congressional Representative.

After the application process for the Congresswoman's nomination is closed, a panel will conduct interviews with candidates who meet all requirements. For each vacancy at a Service Academy, the panel will nominate 10 people. (Alternates will also be recommended but not submitted unless requested by the Service Academy.) The final ranking and appointment will be at the discretion of the Military Service Academies. The Military Academy will then reach out to the nominees to inform them of their appointment status between February and May.

Each member of Congress is allowed five Cadets or Midshipmen at each of the Service Academies in any one year. For each vacancy, the member may nominate up to 10 candidates to compete for that vacancy. Once a student is appointed to an academy, that student fills that vacancy slot until he/she graduates from that Service Academy. Therefore, the number of vacancies available for a member of Congress to nominate candidates depends on the number of cadets currently attending the Service Academy assigned to that member of Congress.

What are the basic eligibility requirements?

Each applicant for a nomination must meet the following eligibility requirements as of July 1st of the year of admission to an academy:

- Age: Be at least 17 years old, but not have passed the 23rd* birthday*
- Citizenship: Must be a U.S. citizen
- Marital Status: Must be unmarried, not pregnant, and without legal obligation to support children or other dependents
- Residence: Must reside within the boundaries of the 22nd Congressional District of Florida.
- Skill / Fitness: Must meet the medical, physical, and academic requirements of the Academy.

What must be included in my nomination file?

A complete nomination file consists of the following items:

^{*}Candidates applying to the Merchant Marine Academy can apply up to their 25th birthday.

- Your application
- Current photo (with your name written on the back)
- Official High school transcript (report cards do not count)
- ACT and/or SAT results must be sent to us directly from the testing center. Please use the following codes: SAT- 5673 and ACT- 7342
- A personal statement, in no more than 500 words, stating why you want to attend a service academy
- Another personal statement that answers in no more than 500 words: what characteristics do you possess that would make you a good fit and/ or successful at the academy
- Three letters of recommendation from individuals outside of your family, sealed, and signed across the seal by the person making the recommendation.
- Contact information for the people writing the letters of recommendation

How many academies are there?

There are five service academies.

- U.S. Military Academy at West Point, New York
- <u>U.S. Naval Academy</u> at Annapolis, Maryland
- U.S. Air Force Academy at Colorado Springs
- <u>U.S. Merchant Marine Academy</u> at Kings Point, New York
- U.S. Coast Guard Academy at New London, Connecticut

Are the requirements the same for all of the service academies?

No. Although many of the qualifications are similar, each academy operates under its own admissions guidelines. Visit the academy of your choice via the websites noted for each academy's particular admissions qualifications.

Who should I ask to write a letter of recommendation on my behalf?

Some of the people applicants typically seek recommendations from include:

^{*}Please note that I cannot offer a nomination for the Coast Guard since they do not require nominations. It is not necessary to seek a nomination to the Coast Guard Academy since the U.S.C.G.A. accepts candidates based on their own testing criteria.

^{*}Please note that you must also apply through the service academy.

- Teachers
- Counselors
- Employers
- Coaches
- Clergy
- Scout Leaders

When is the deadline to apply for a Congressional nomination from Congresswoman Frankel?

All components of your packet must be received by 5 pm (EST) on October 31st, 2025. It is your responsibility to ensure that we have received your completed packet by the deadline.

Will I automatically be selected by the academy after I receive a nomination?

No. You will be placed among a select group of nominees, and the academy of your choice will make the final decision. If selected, you will receive an offer of admission (an appointment) directly from the academy.

What if I choose more than one academy? Will I be limited to a single nomination?

No. You can be nominated to multiple academies depending on how well you have competed among this year's pool of candidates. It is also possible to win multiple appointments.

When will I know if I have been offered an appointment by an academy?

Academies will begin to notify candidates of their admission status in February. All offers of appointment are generally sent out by May.

^{*}I do not require a specific recommendation form. A letter of recommendation is sufficient.

Consequently, mail sent directly to our Washington, D.C. office may not be physically received by our D.C. office for four to six weeks, after which it must be forwarded back to our Delray Beach office, which may take an additional one to two weeks.
- It is your responsibility to ensure that we have received your entire application by the deadline.
- Please note that not all applications may receive a congressional nomination. Also, a congressional nomination does not guarantee an appointment. (Call our office or your desired academy if you have any questions).
- Falsifying information in this application will result in a disqualification for the opportunity to receive a nomination.
